Note: The Congregation Council and the Interim will negotiate the terms of this covenant agreement. Interim Ministry will begin at this congregation when this form is completed and signed by the Interim and Congregation President, and returned for the Bishop's signature.

In accordance with the model constitution for congregations of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, the Bishop of the Indiana-Kentucky Synod, with the concurrence of the congregation council, is responsible for the appointment of an interim when a congregation is in the time of transition between pastors.

The Interim Pastor shall have all the rights and duties of a regularly called pastor and, with the concurrence of the congregation council, may delegate the same in part to a supply pastor. The Interim Pastor, and any ordained ministers who may assist, shall refrain from influence in the selection of a pastor. The Interim Pastor shall report monthly to the congregation council and the Bishop and, upon completion of service, shall certify to the Bishop of this synod that the parochial records for the period of the interim are in order.
